Specific Issues of Interest to the CCB:

China Notifies Updated Phytosanitary Certificate

- China <u>notified</u> the WTO of an updated template for <u>phytosanitary certificates</u> and <u>phytosanitary certificates for re-export</u>.
- The new certificates will be used from June 1, 2023. A transition period will be in place until December 31, 2023, during which both the old and new version will be accepted.
- The proposed date of adoption and publication of the new templates is May 31, 2023. Comments can be sent to the U.S. SPS Inquiry Point at <u>us.spsenquirypoint@fas.usda.gov</u>. The WTO comment deadline is May 31, 2023.

USDA Publishes Report on Tariff Reductions Under U.S.-Japan Trade Agreement

- A recent USDA GAIN <u>report</u> highlights the reduction and elimination of tariffs on U.S. exports under the U.S.-Japan Trade Agreement (USJTA). The latest round of reductions occurred on April 1, marking year five of USJTA implementation.
- Of note to CCB, the remaining Japanese tariff on U.S. sweet cherries (HS 0809.29) has been eliminated. The value of Japanese cherry imports from the U.S. in 2022 was \$27.43 million.
- Japanese Customs requires importers to submit a country of origin declaration to claim preferential tariff treatment under the USJTA. USDA provides <u>USJTA rules</u> of origin and origin procedures.

General Issues of Interest to the CCB:

USDA Provides English Translation of Chinese Food Contact Material Draft Amendment

- On March 6, China notified the WTO of a draft amendment to *GB 9685-2016 on the use of additive for food contact materials and articles.* The draft standard had previously been made available for comment (in Chinese) in February (*BCI Monitor 3-7-23, 2-14-23*).
- The USDA recently published a <u>GAIN report</u> with an unofficial English translation of the amendment.
