General Issues of Interest to the CCB:

Canada Opens Consultation on Modernization of Food Compositional Standards

- On June 23, Health Canada and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) opened a consultation on a proposal to modernize its process for modifying or establishing food compositional standards using incorporation by reference.
- More than 500 food compositional standards for 20 categories of food are included in the <u>Food and Drug Regulations (FDR)</u> and related <u>Safe Food for</u> <u>Canadians Regulations (SFCR)</u> and are also <u>incorporated by reference (IBR)</u> into these regulations.
- Health Canada and CFIA are seeking to modernize the regulatory process to address non-health and safety aspects of the compositional standards through IBR documents to allow for more efficient updates without the need to amend regulation texts.
- CFIA has published a consultation <u>discussion paper</u> setting out the anticipated process – including criteria for screening modification requests, prioritization, and consolidating requests – and is seeking feedback on the proposed strategy.
- The consultation is open until September 22, 2023. Health Canada and CFIA

Japan Notifies Amendment to Requirements for Synthetic Resin Food Contact Materials

- On June 22, Japan <u>notified</u> the WTO of a Ministry of Health, Labour, and Welfare (MHLW) <u>amendment</u> (in English) to the *Specifications and Standards* for Foods, Food Additives, Etc., revising specifications for synthetic resin used in food contact materials.
- This amendment will enter into force simultaneously with Japan's larger positive list system for approved substances in food contact materials, on June 1, 2025. A MHLW guide on the positive list system (in Japanese) provides detailed information and relevant updates.
