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General Issues of Interest to the CCB:

European Union Opens Consultation on EU Organic Production Logo

- The European Commission (EC) opened a <u>public consultation</u> regarding changes to approved formats of the European Union (EU) organic logo.
- According to the <u>draft delegated regulation</u> amending Regulation (EU) 2018/848
 regarding the EU organic production logo, the changes will clarify provisions to
 ensure a totally inverted white and black (negative) model may also be used for
 the logo.
- Notably, the EU and U.S. maintain recognition of <u>organic legislation equivalency</u> through their Trade and Cooperation Agreement.
- Comments can be submitted until May 28, 2024, by providing feedback via the EC consultation webpage. Commission adoption is planned for the third quarter of 2024.

UK Notifies WTO of Border Target Operating Model Implementation Date

- On April 24, the United Kingdom (UK) <u>notified</u> the WTO of the implementation of its second milestone in its <u>Border Target Operating Model</u> (BTOM), which will commence on April 30 (*BCI Monitors 8-29-23, 4-23-24*).
- Implemented through two Statutory Instruments adopted on April 22, <u>The Official Controls (Extension of Transitional Periods) (Amendment) Regulations 2024</u> and <u>The Official Controls (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2024</u>, the second milestone introduces documentary and risk-based identity and physical checks on imports of medium risk animal products, plants, and plant products, as well as on imports of high-risk food and feed of non-animal origin from the European Union (EU).
